RESOLUTION 2009-02

Calling For The End Of The Corrupt Earmarking Process

WHEREAS "Earmarks"----the process by which Federal Expenditures breeze through the U.S. Congress in contrast with the deliberative process required for an actual Spending-&-Appropriation Bill; and

WHEREAS the process of reviewing a proposed earmark expenditure never occurs because the earmark expenditure is commingled with other proposed----sometimes fiscal legislation (then see enclosed copy of "Political Greed" by U.S. Senator DeMint of South Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BAY COUNTY (FLA.) REPUBLICAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, IN REGULAR SESSION, DEMANDS that U.S. Congress should, at once, end the corruption characterized by the earmark process and this concept should be denounced on the House and Senate Floors by ethical members of our House and Senate.
